Thank you for being so faithful in your support of our church’s ministries and missions. Stewardship is not just about giving money to financially support the church; it’s about using your gifts and talents to physically and spiritually participate in those ministries and missions.

We recently hosted a Rise Against Hunger event where nearly 70 of us packaged 10,000 meals that will be used to feed people around the world. What an amazing time of fellowship and love. Our adult mission team chose to work near home this fall, doing mission work right here in our own community. What a blessing those adults were to the folks they helped. You serve meals to our Homebound and make prayer shawls for those facing difficulties in their lives. You hug people and greet them warmly when they walk through our doors. You show love to others because of your relationship with Jesus Christ our Lord and Savior.

In addition to supporting our general budget with your Faith Promises, you have gone the 2nd Mile by supporting the following designated funds: Pastor’s Discretionary Fund, Capital Improvement, Rise Against Hunger, Children and Youth ministries, Helping Hands Mission and Homebound Ministries.

As of September 16th we have received \$242,500 towards our general budget. Our Endowment now has 3,094 shares valued at \$45,616. All of our bills and apportionments are paid up to date. God is so good! I am so thankful for each of you and your generous spirits. It is humbling to worship God with you.
