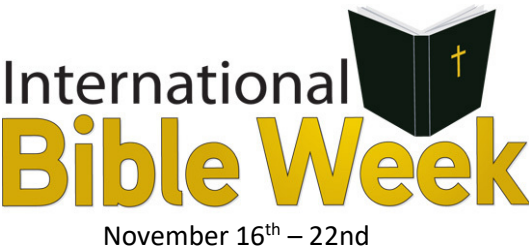
Bethany Change of Mailing Address
