NOTE ON MUSIC FOR ADVENT

Our organ and piano music today is based upon the great Advent hymn *Savior of the Nations, Come* (UMH No. 214). Attributed to St. Ambrose, father of Western hymnody, the text was translated from Latin into German by Martin Luther. With the addition of a melody adapted from Gregorian chant, the unaccompanied songs of the medieval church, Luther created one of the most beautiful chorales – as congregational hymns were called in the 16th century.

Embracing the whole of Christ's life, death, and resurrection, *Savior of the Nations, Come* inspired Johann Sebastian Bach to compose three chorale preludes for organ, the first of which we will hear today as a piano transcription by the visionary Italian-German composer Ferruccio Busoni (1866-1924). Bach embellished the hymn tune in the style of an opera aria, supported by a "walking bass" in the organ pedals (played here by the pianist's left hand). The effect is a profound sense of mysticism quite in keeping with the theme of Christ's incarnation. -Rudy Shackelford
