Jubilee Churches Update - As of February 23rd, Tessa Combs, Housing Resource Advocate for GUEST, said that they still had several requests for assistance in process that will likely be assisted; right now, Jubilee Churches has assisted 2 households, one with rent and one with Dominion Power totaling \$1,078. She has 4 pending requests that if approved, the balance of the Jubilee Fund would be \$6,549 (it is currently \$9,593). Over \$36,000 was given last year to Jubilee Churches.
